<b>Arrive:</b>	CTK Ministries Building, <b>Monday, 02/15/10, at approximately 5:30 pm.</b> (Troop will wear Class A uniforms and attend Sunday Mass in Baton Rouge)
<b>Fees:</b>	<b>\$95 check payable to Troop 29 due 01/05/10 with permission slip. The fee covers bus, USS Kidd, Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast, and Monday breakfast expenses. The troop is subsidizing a healthy portion of this trips expense.</b>  <b>\$22.00 (Cash)</b> estimated per scout expense to be carried by scout on trip for Sunday lunch, Sunday dinner, and Monday lunch.
