The troop committee is the troop's board of directors. It supports the troop's adult and youth leaders in delivering a quality program to the troop's Scouts. The committee includes the following positions: chairperson, secretary, treasurer, advancement coordinator, chaplain, outdoor/activities coordinator, training coordinator, quartermaster / equipment coordinator. The committee meets monthly, approximately 9 times a year. Would you be willing to hold a troop committee position?	
The troop periodically needs adult volunteers for various activities such as coordinating Merit Badge University (MBU) registration and logistics, building Eagle Scout shadow boxes, or coordinating Sharefest activities. Are you willing to assist in these type of activities?	
Troop adults are required to complete the CTK Protecting God's Children (Virtus) training program. This is a one time, classroom activity with periodic internet bulletin refresher sessions. Are you willing to complete the required CTK training classes?	
Depending on the troop position held, troop adults are required to complete various BSA training courses (Youth Protection, Safe Swim Defense, Safety Afloat, Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills, New Leader Essentials, Leader Specific Training.) Several courses are available online. The Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills course usually occurs on a Saturday with an adult overnight campout. The New Leader Essentials and Leader Specific Training courses are usually addressed on a Saturday or two week nights. Are you willing to complete the appropriate BSA training for your position?
